ORDER

The petitioner M/s. Shree Ganesh Rice Mill has filed an application u/S. 142 of the Electricity Act, 2003 for non-implementation of the Order dated 25.03.2010 passed by the GRF, Bolangir, in C.C. Case No. 104/2010. The same is registered as Case No. 139/2010 by the OERC. The Commission heard the matter on 08.11.2011 and vide its order dated 21.11.2011 had directed the petitioner and the Respondent-WESCO (now WESCO Utility) to sit together and find out a solution to settle the disputed bills of the petitioner. The Commission had also directed OPTCL to furnish the date-wise chart of implementation schedule of the 132 KV S/S at Nuapada along with associated 132 KV line etc.

2. According to the directions of the Commission vide order dated 21.11.2011, the respondents have submitted that they have taken steps for revision of the bills of the petitioner and are removing the voltage problems and power interruption. Now the voltage profile of the petitioner is as per voltage under guaranteed standards of performance of the OERC's Regulation. The Respondent No-2 (OPTCL) has already submitted the status of progress with regards to execution of 132/33 KV Nuapada grid S/S. The associated 132 KV lines from Khariar to Nuapada has been energized and commissioned with one 132/33 KV, 20 MVA transformer on 27.12.2014. The 2nd 132/33 KV, 20 MVA transformer has also been commissioned on 23.05.2015.

- 3. Since the order of the GRF, Bolangir in C. C. Case No. 104/2010 and so also order of the OERC dated 21.011.2011 has been complied with by the respondents, there is no need to proceed further in the above case.
- 4. Accordingly, the Section 142 proceeding under the Electricity Act, 2003 is dropped.
