## **ORDER**

The case came before us today for hearing on question of admission.

- 2. Heard the parties at length.
- 3. In the instant case National Consumer Disputes Redressal Commission has given liberty to the petitioner to agitate his grievance and enforce his right before this Commission u/S.43 of the Electricity Act, 2003. The Electricity Act, 2003 has exclusive and elaborate provisions for redressal of consumer grievances, if any of his right is violated, under S.43 of the Electricity Act, 2003. The Commission has framed OERC (Grievance Redressal Forum & Ombudsman) Regulations, 2004 under S. 42 and S. 181 of the Electricity Act, 2003. As this Commission has no direct jurisdiction to hear the grievance of the consumers, while specialized Fora are existing exclusively for this purpose, the petitioner may approach the same concerned Forum (i.e., GRF, Cuttack) in the area of supply.
- 4. With the above observation the Commission is not inclined to admit the case and accordingly, the case is disposed of.
