**ORDER**

**Date of Order:17.06.2016**

The petitioner Shri Bishnu Charan Sahoo has filed an application u/S. 142 of the Electricity Act, 2003 for non-implementation of the Order dated 19.01.2009 of the Ombudsman-II passed in C.R.Case No. Om-II (N)-17/2008. The Commission had taken up the matter for hearing on 25.05.2010 and by admitting the above case had directed in its interim order as follows:-

***“x x x x x x x However, the respondent is directed to serve the said revised bill afresh and the petitioner is also directed to make payment of the arrear amount on or before 30.06. 2010 x x x x.”***

Now in compliance to the Letter No. 552 dated 30.04.2016 of the Commission regarding status of the case, the Respondents have submitted that they had already revised the bills of the petitioner for the period from February, 2005 to January, 2009 and an amount of Rs. 14204.50 (Rupees Fourteen thousand two hundred four and fifty paisa) only has withdrawn from the bill for the month of May, 2010. Now the consumer-Petitioner is billed basing on the actual meter reading and there is no outstanding arrear against the petitioner till the month of March, 2016.

Therefore, there is no need to proceed further u/S. 142 of the Electricity Act, 2003 in this case further as the order dated 25.05.2010 of the Commission has already been complied by the respondents. Accordingly, the case is dropped.
