The petitioner Shri Trilochan Dash, Director, M/s. Krupalu Rice Industries Pvt. Ltd. of Village Panikoili, Jajpur, in the supply area of NESCO under the Executive Engineer (Electrical), Jajpur Road Electrical Division, NESCO, Jajpur has filed an application u/S. 142 of the Electricity Act, 2003 for non-implementation of order dated 02.03.2012 of the Ombudsman-II passed in C.R. Case No.77.of 2011& Order dated 01.10.2012 of the OERC passed in Case No.74 of 2012.

During pendency of the above petition for adjudication, the Commission has issued show cause notice on 23.11.2013 to the Executive Engineer (Electrical), Jajpur Road Electrical Division, NESCO the respondent herein as to why a proceeding u/S. 142 of the Electricity Act, 2003 will not be initiated against him for the above lapses on his part.

According to the above show cause notice of the Commission, the respondent has filed compliance report on 09.01.2014 regarding implementation of the order dated 02.03.2012 of the Ombudsman-II passed in C.R. Case No.77.of 2011 so also the order dated 01.10.2012 of the OERC passed in Case No.74 of 2012 with due intimation of the same to the petitioner. The Petitioner has also admitted the above fact regarding implementation of the said order of the Ombudsman-II dated 06.01.2014 to the

Commission. Therefore, there is no need to initiate proceeding u/S. 142 of the Electricity Act, 2003 against the Executive Engineer(Electrical), Jajpur Road Electrical Division, NESCO, Jajpur as he has complied the said order of the Ombudsman-II passed in C.R. Case No. 77 of 2011.

Accordingly the case is dropped. The above order of the Commission may be communicated to the parties concerned and also placed in the website of the Commission.
