**ORDER**

1. Brief fact of the case is that, the petitioner has filed this case u/S. 142 of the Act. for non-implementation of the order dated 06.05.2013 of the Commission passed in Case No. 15/2013 which is as follows:-

*“After hearing the parties and perusal of the case records, the Commission directs the respondents to implement the order issued by the Appellate Authority within 15 days of issue of this order and furnish a compliance report to the Commission as early as possible”*

2. During the hearing the representative of the respondents has submitted that the respondents have complied the direction of the Commission given in Case No. 15/2013 during pendency of the above case. An amount of RS 35,000/- (Thirty-five thousand) only has been refunded though Cheque bearing No. 002152 on 01.08.2013 by the SDO (Elect.), Anandapur and the said amount has also been received by the petitioner on 03.08.2013. The rest of the amount will be adjusted by in the future bills. The delay for implementation of the order of the Commission is not intentional. He

also further submitted that the reconnection charge which was received from the petitioner will be refunded within 7 days.

3. After hearing the parties and perusal of the case records, the Commission observed that there is no such intentional delay for implement of its order passed in Case No. 15/2013 and the petitioner also admits that he has received Rs. 35,000/- from the respondents on 03.08.2013. The Commission now direct the respondents to refund the reconnection charge which has been received from the petitioner within 7 days from today and also adjust the balance amount, if any in his future electricity bills.
4. With the above directions, the case is disposed of. .
