ORDER

The petitioner M/s Suryo Udyog Ltd. is an Ice Manufacturing and Marine Product Export Unit in Paradeep Electrical Division, CESU, Paradeep. The petitioner has filed the above case u/S. 142 of the Electricity Act, 2003 for non-implementation of the order dated 05.02.2013 of the GRF, Paradeep passed in C.C.Case No.247 of 2012 wherein the GRF, Paradeep after hearing the parties had disposed of the complaint case with the following directions:-

- " x x x OP shall adjust the said estimated amount of Rs. 1,10,912/- towards augmentation on 11 KV line in respect of enhancement of load of 310 KVA to 500 KVA of the petitioner company i.e. M/s Suryo Udyog Ltd. in the monthly bills not exceeding 24 months which is as per OERC Distribution (Conditions of Supply) Code, 2004 Appendix-1 Para-11 (iii). As the OP did not furnish the remunerative calculation, it was prepared at this end, which is enclosed. Such remunerative calculation is as per the Rule 13 (1) of the OERC Distribution (Conditions of Supply) Code, 2004 from such remunerative calculation it is established that such scheme is fully remunerative x x x x x"
- 2. The case is taken up today on question of admission and hearing.
- 3. Heard the parties at length. During hearing the Executive Engineer (Elect.), PED,

Paradeep has submitted that the respondents have implemented the above order of the GRF, Paradeep passed in C.C. Case No. 247/2012 the same fact is also admitted by the authorized representative of the petitioner present during the hearing.

- 4. Therefore, there is no need to proceed further in the matter u/S. 142 of the Electricity Act, 2003 against the respondents as they have complied the said order dated 05.02.2013 of the GRF, Paradeep passed in C.C. Case No. 247/2012. The case is dropped.
- 5. Accordingly the case is disposed of.
