The present petition has been filed by Shri Dinabandhu Jena of Village - Tirakhua, P.O: Kanheibindha, P.S: Simulia, Dist.-Balasore for non-compliance of order dated 21.05.2014 of the Ombudsman-II passed in C.R. Case No. Omb (II) N-25/2014 invoking the jurisdiction of the Commission under Section 142 of Electricity Act, 2003 against the respondents.

- 2. The petitioner has also submitted that the Ombudsman-II disposed of C.R. Case No. Omb (II) N-25/2014 with the following observations:-
 - "1 The respondent is directed to replace the 25 KVA transformer of Tirukha substation with 63 KVA transformers under system improvement scheme and draw required lines to give supply to consumers now fed from other substation.
 - 2. The cost of shifting of poles will be shared by the consumers availing power supply from the new line, failing which the total cost of shifting of line and poles will be paid by the petitioner.

The respondent is directed to act as per the conclusions made above within 30 days from the date of the receipt of this letter of acceptance of order of the petitioner and report compliance to this Forum within 45 days"

- 3. The representative of the respondents has submitted that as per order of the Ombudsman-II passed in C.R. Case No. Omb (II) N-25/2014, the respondents have replaced the transformer and shifted the line and poles as on 25.08.2014. The said work was delayed due to transfer of the J.E in charge of the work and joining of a new incumbent in July, 2014.
- 4. Heard the respondents at length. As the order of the Ombudsman-II passed in C.R. Case No. Omb (II) N-25/2014 has been complied by the respondents, there is no need to proceed further in this matter.
- 5. With the above observations, the present application is disposed of.
