## <u>Order</u>

The present application has been filed by Shri Ashok Kumar Agrawal, a consumer of WESCO Utility under the SE, Electrical Circle, Sambalpur, seeking direction of the Commission to the respondents for implementation of order dated 05.08.2013 of the GRF-Burla passed in C.C.Case No. 28/2013/14 wherein, the learned GRF has directed both the Executive Engineer (Elect.), SED, Sambalpur and the SE (Elect.), Electrical Circle, Sambalpur, to take up the matter and solve the dispute at their level. As the above direction of the learned GRF, Burla has not been complied by the respondents, the petitioner has filed the present petition.

- 2. The representative of the WESCO Utility submitted that an agreement in this regard has been made out basing on the amicable settlement between the parties on 04.07.2015 signed by the consumer Petitioner and the Respondents wherein the Petitioner has undertaken to withdraw the present case. The representative also submitted a copy of the said minutes of settlement between the Petitioner and Respondents and requested the Commission to drop the proceeding under Section 142 of the Electricity Act, 2003.
- 3. Nobody was present from the Petitioner's side on repeated calls.

- 4. After hearing the Respondents and perusing the case record we find that the dispute has been settled outside the court and therefore, there is no need to proceed further in this case. The proceeding under Section 142 of the Electricity Act against the respondent is hereby dropped.
- 5. Accordingly, the case is disposed of.
