ORDER

The petitioner has filed the above case u/S. 142 f the Electricity Act, 2003 for non-compliance of the order dated 29.10.2014 passed by the Appellate Authority-cum-Deputy Electrical Inspector (T&D), Govt. of Odisha, Jajpur Road in Case No. AAC No-16/2014 so also order dated 22.06.2015 of the GRF, Balasore passed in C.C.Case No. 77/2015.

2. Prior to fixing a date for hearing, the Commission had issued show-cause notice to the respondent in the above noted case for filing of reply why the above order of the GRF, Balasore so also the order dated 29.10.2014 passed by the Appellate Authority, u/S. 127 of the Electricity Act, 2003 have not been complied with. In its reply, the SDO (Elect.), Soro Electrical Sub-division has submitted that against the above order of the Appellate Authority in Case No. AAC No. 16/2014, NESCO Utility has moved to the

Hon'ble High Court of Orissa in W.P.(C). No. 18481 of 2015. The Hon'ble Court vide their judgement dated 14.10.2015 has dismissed the said writ petition with an observation that the appellate authority has passed a reasoned order.

- 3. Heard the parties at length. As the Hon'ble High Court has already dismissed the writ application filed by the NESCO Utility challenging the order dated 29.10.2014 passed by the Appellate Authority-cum-Deputy Electrical Inspector (T&D), Jajpur Road in Case No. AAC No. 16/2014 vide their judgment dated 14.10.2015 in W.P.(C). No. 18481 of 2015, the respondent is directed to implement the said order of the Appellate Authority passed u/S. 127 of the Electricity Act, 2003 in Case No. AAC No. 16/2014 and GRF order in C.C.Cace No. 77/2015 within 10 days from today with intimation to the Commission. In the event the above order of the Commission is not complied and reported to the Commission in time, a penalty @ Rs.1000/- (One thousand) only per day shall be recovered from the erring officer of NESCO Utility by the higher authority till the date of compliance and deposited in the appropriate accounts by way of penalty u/S. 142 of the Electricity Act, 2003.
- 4. With the above directions, the case is disposed of.
