Sri Rabindra Nath Das, Chhatia, Jajpur has filed the above case under section 142 of the Electricity Act, 2003 due to non-implementation of Order dated 24.07.2017 of the Ombudsman-I passed in C.R.Case No. 80 of 2017 by the Executive Engineer(Elect.), CED, CESU, Cuttack. The Ombudsman-I while disposing of C.R.Case No. 80 of 2017 has directed the respondents to revise the electricity bills of the petitioner from January, 2013 to February, 2017 taking average of full three continuous month's consumption after the installation of the new meter on 24.02.2017 within 30 days of that order. The petitioner was directed to deposit the revised bill amount within 30 days of receiving the bills.

2. The Commission decided to hear the matter on 18.08.2020 though Video Conferencing in the Virtual Court. Respondent is not present during hearing through video conferencing but he has filed an affidavit stating therein that the respondent has already implemented the order dated 24.07.2017 of the Ombudsman-I passed in C.R.Case No. 80 of 2017. As per the order of the Ombudsman-I the bill has been revised and an amount of Rs.86,414/- has been

credited to the account of the petitioner in the bill of June, 2020. The same fact is admitted by the petitioner.

- 3. The authorised representative of the petitioner submits during virtual hearing that the order dated 24.07.2017 of the Ombudsman-I passed in C.R.Case No. 80 of 2017 has been complied by the respondent fully.
- 4. As the order dated 24.07.2017 of the Ombudsman-I passed in C.R.Case No. 80 of 2017 has been compiled by the respondent there is no need to proceed further in this matter.
- 5. The case is closed as the order of the Ombudsman-I is complied.
