Sri Kishanlal Agrawal, Nayabazar, Cuttack has filed the above case under section 142 of the Electricity Act,2003 for non-implementation of order dated 01.11.2019 of the Ombudsman-I passed in C.R. Case No.67 of 2019 impleading the Executive Engineer(Elect.), CDD-II, Badambadi, CESU, Cuttack. The Ombudsman-I while disposing of C.R.Case No.67 of 2019 has directed the respondent herein not to include the transformer loss units in the billing units of the petitioner with effect from August,2018 onwards and bill the petitioner in L.T. domestic category tariff until the installation of H.T. metering system. As the above order of the Ombudsman-I has not been complied by the respondent, the petitioner has approached this Commission for compliance of the above order of the Ombudsman and also for a direction to the respondent not to disconnect power supply till revision of the bill with rebate date for payment.

2. The Commission decided to hear the matter on 14.07.2020 though Video Conferencing in the Virtual Court and accordingly notice dated 07.07.2020 was issued to the parties concerned. Respondent has submitted through video conferencing that as per order of the Ombudsman-I the bill of the petitioner has been revised and after revision of the bill the differential amount of Rs.6,870.93 added in the bill of the petitioner in the month of

December, 2019. The revision statement has also been supplied to the petitioner vide office letter No.53 dated 04.01.2020. Therefore, the present case may be dropped as the order of the Ombudsman-I dated 01.11.2019 passed in C.R.Case No.67 of 2019 has been complied.

3. During virtual hearing, the Authorized representative of the petitioner has also admitted the above fact that the said order of the Ombudsman-I dated 01.11.2019 passed in C.R. Case No.67 of 2019 has been complied by the respondent.
4. As the order of the Ombudsman-I dated 01.11.2019 passed in C.R.Case No.67 of 2019 has been complied by the respondent there is no need to proceed further in the above matter.
5. With the above observation the case is disposed of.
