The Petitioner has submitted that the "Green Tariff" be made applicable to the consumer who want to avail Green Energy and bear procurement cost of such energy and transmission and distribution cost.

2. OERC Tariff Regulation, 2014 at Regulation 6.3 provides that the annual filing for Retail Supply Tariff shall include tariff for each consumer category, slab wise and voltage wise. The proposed tariff shall also contain energy charges, demand charges, minimum fixed charges, etc. along with tariff rationalisation measures. The tariff proposal of licensee should demonstrate that tariffs are progressively reflecting the cost of supply. Similarly, Conduct of Business Regulation 2004 in Chapter VI at Regulation 51 and 53 stipulates that the Commission shall hear power purchase and tariff matter of licensees as per the Regulation.

- 3. Therefore, this tariff application should be heard as a part of the Annual Tariff filing of the licensees. Once it becomes part of the tariff filing process of DISCOMs, all the stakeholders including general public can be consulted under Section 64 of the Act.
- Therefore, the present petition is not maintainable in the present form. The Petitioner 4. is at liberty to raise the issue in the upcoming tariff filing and hearing.
- 5. Accordingly, the case is disposed of.
