The petitioner Sri Aurobindo Yogo Niketan, Panikoili, Jajpur has come up with application under Section 142 of the Electricity Act, 2003 for non-compliance of order dated 24.05.2022 of the Ombudsman-II passed in C.R. Case No. N-07 of 2022. The learned Ombudsman-II while disposing of C.R. Case No. N-07 of 2022 has directed the respondent as follows:-

***“The respondent is directed to revise the disputed bill of the petitioner from October, 2015 to September, 2020 by taking monthly average of consecutive six months consumption of the new OK meter installed in the month of October, 2020 bearing Sl. No. 829460 and serve to the petitioner within 15 days from the date of receipt of letter of acceptance from the petitioner and file compliance before this Authority within 30 days.*”**

The case is accordingly disposed of.”

2. As the above order of the Ombudsman-II passed in C.R. Case No. N-07 of 2022 was not complied by the Respondent, the petitioner herein has approached the Commission for compliance under Section 142 of the Electricity Act, 2003.

3. Heard the Parties at length. During hearing the Executive Engineer (Electrical), JRED, Jajpur Road, TPNODL submitted that the order of Ombudsman-II passed in C.R. Case No. N-07 of 2022 has been complied by the respondent. As per the order of the Ombudsman-II, the respondent has revised the disputed bill of the petitioner from October, 2015 to September, 2020 by taking monthly average of consecutive six months consumption of the new OK meter installed in the consumer premises and the said rectified bill has been served to the petitioner in the month of September, 2022. The Respondent has prayed the Commission not to proceed further in this case under Section 142 of the Electricity Act, 2003 since the order of Ombudsman-II has been complied.
4. The case is dropped as the order dated 24.05.2022 of the Ombudsman-II passed in C.R. Case No. N-07 of 2022 has been complied by the respondent.
5. With the above observation, the case is disposed of.
