**ORDER**

The petitioner M/s. B.R. Associates, N.I.E., Jagatpur, Cuttack has come up with an application under Section 142 of the Electricity Act, 2003 for non-compliance of order dated 01.06.2022 of the GRF, Cuttack passed in C.C. Case No.397 of 2022 by the Respondent-E.E.(Elect.), TPCODL.

The learned GRF, Cuttack, while disposing of the above case of consumer complaint, has directed the respondent as follows:-

- “1.    The O.P. (Respondent herein) is directed to prepare the bills for each month starting from 05/2021 to 04/2022 taking KVAH reading into consideration with IMR “1984.94” [01.05.2021] and closing reading of “2356.10” [01.05.2022]. The correct KVAH readings for the respective months shall be adopted as tabulated above from the available dump data.*
- 2.    The O.P. (Respondent herein) is directed to serve a copy of revision statement to the complainant for its perusal.*
- 3.    Interim order dated 22.04.2022 hereby vacated.”*
2.    The authorized representative of the petitioner submits that as the order dated 01.06.2022 of the GRF, Cuttack passed in C.C. Case No. 397 of 2022 has not been

complied by the Respondent, the petitioner herein has filed the above case for implementation of the above order dated 01.06.2022 of the GRF, Cuttack.

3. The respondent has submitted that in obedience to the above order of the GRF, Cuttack, the bill of the Petitioner-consumer was revised and after approval of SE (Elect.), Cuttack, vide his Letter No. 1156, dated 30.06.2022, the revised amount of Rs.2,22,863/- has been debited to the consumer account which is reflected on the EC bill served on 17.08.2022 to the petitioner. Therefore, the Respondent has prayed the Commission to drop the proceedings initiated under Section 142 of the Electricity Act, 2003 as the order passed by GRF, Cuttack passed in C.C. Case No. 397 of 2022 has already been complied.
4. During hearing, the authorized representative of the Petitioner has not agreed with the compliance report submitted by the Respondent against the order passed by the GRF, Cuttack passed in C.C. Case No.397 of 2022 as it has not been complied to the satisfaction of the petitioner.
5. Heard the representative of the Petitioner and the Respondent at length through virtual mode. Since the Petitioner is not satisfied with the Respondent in so far as compliance of the GRF, Cuttack passed in C.C. Case No.397 of 2022, the matter is remanded to GRF, Cuttack to verify as to whether their order has been complied in letter and spirit or not. The GRF, Cuttack is directed to take up the matter for hearing on **27.12.2022** to ascertain the status of implementation of their order with due notice to the parties concerned and shall record findings by hearing both the parties. The Petitioner is at liberty to approach this forum, if GRF, Cuttack finds that their order passed in C.C. Case No. 397 of 2022 has not been complied with.
6. With the above directions to the parties, the case is disposed of. The Registry is directed to send a copy of this order to GRF, Cuttack along with the copy of the petition
