ORDER

The Petitioner- M/s. Sri Ram Rice Mill, At-Champati, P.O:Bhairpur in the District of Cuttack has filed the present petition under Section 142 of the Electricity Act, 2003 alleging contravention and non-implementation of order dated 31.03.2023 passed by the GRF, Cuttack in C.C. Case No.57 of 2023.

2. The Learned GRF, Cuttack while disposing of C.C. Case No.57 of 2023 directed as follows:

“1. The Opposite Party is directed to withdraw the transformer loss w.e.f. 04/2018 to 04/2020 as well as revise and withdrawal of excess MMFC charged on the basis of CD instead of MD w.e.f. 06/2012 and give necessary credit to the complainant.

2. The Opposite Party is directed to revise and withdraw the DPS already charged from 09/2012 to 01.2023 in accordance with the Tariff Notifications by the Commission from time to time.

The Opposite Party is directed to submit the compliance report to this Forum within a month from the date of issue of this order.”

3. As the above Order of the Learned GRF, Cuttack was not complied with by the Respondent-TPCODL, the Petitioner herein moved the Commission filing the present Case under Section 142 of the Electricity Act, 2003 for implementation of order dated 31.03.2023 passed by the GRF, Cuttack in C.C. Case No.57 of 2023.
4. Heard the parties. In course of hearing, the Learned Counsel appearing on behalf of the Respondent-Licensee, submitted that the Respondent in compliance with the order of the Learned GRF, Cuttack passed in C.C. Case No.57 of 2023 has revised the bill of the

Petitioner-Consumer from 4/2018 to 4/2020 towards transformer loss and credited the requisite amount in the account of the Petitioner-Consumer and it is submitted that the other parts of the order would be complied with by the Respondent-Licensee within a month.

5. Considering the above submissions of the parties, the Commission by allowing one month time, directs the Respondent-Licensee to comply with the remaining part of the order dated 31.03.2023 of the GRF, Cuttack passed in C.C.Case No.57 of 2023 in letter and spirit within a month hence with intimation to the Petitioner-Consumer and the Commission.
6. Thus, the Commission observes that no dispute remains regarding the compliance of the order of GRF, Cuttack and the case is dropped.
