- This matter is taken up for hearing through hybrid arrangement.
2. This is an application u/s 142 of the Electricity Act, 2003 wherein the Petitioner has sought a direction from the Commission for implementation of the order dated 04.04.2025, passed by the Learned GRF, Bhubaneswar in C.C. No.62 of 2025, by the Respondent.
 3. When the matter is taken up for hearing today, the Executive Engineer (Tech), Rasulgarh Sub-division submits for closure of the case on the ground that the direction of the Commission imparted in order dated 12.06.2025 has since been carried out. To that effect, a photocopy of the report dated 12.06.2025 of Lineman Jiten Behera and Helper Kasinath Ch. Gupta is annexed to the affidavit. In course of the hearing, the husband of the Petitioner participated in the hearing online. To the query of the Commission, he also admits that the premises of the Petitioner, referred to in the Petition, has since been supplied with electricity and submits that the Petitioner is no longer interested to proceed with this case.
 4. Perusal of our order dated 10.06.2025 reveals that the Respondent-Licensee was directed to extend power supply to the premises of the Petitioner, either temporary or permanent in pursuance of the order dated 04.04.2025 of the Learned GRF. This direction, in view of the admission of the husband of the Petitioner, is found implemented.
 5. In view of the implementation of the order dated 04.04.2025, as admitted by the husband of the Petitioner, the Commission finds nothing more to proceed further with this case. Consequently, the case is disposed of on full satisfaction of the order of the Learned GRF, Bhubaneswar.
