ORDER

This matter is taken up for hearing through hybrid arrangement.

2. The Petitioner- M/s. Raja Agro Cold Storage has filed the instant petition under Section 142 of the Electricity Act, 2003 alleging non-compliance of order dated 12.11.2024 of the OERC passed in Case No.73 of 2024 arising out of order dated 06.06.2018 of the learned GRF, Balasore passed in C.C.No.117 of 2018, finally confirmed in the order dated 11.04.2023 of the Hon'ble High Court, passed in W.P.(C) No.15232 of 2018.
3. It is submitted on behalf of the Respondent-Licensee-TPNODL that the initial supervision charge amounting to Rs.3,00,160/- was revised and reduced to Rs.72,316/- and the balance amount of Rs.2,27,844/- was paid to the petitioner on 13.11.2024 and that a further sum of Rs.22,909/- towards interest @10% as per the order of the Hon'ble High Court, passed in W.P (C) No.15232 of 2018 pursuant to the Order dated 12.11.2024 of the Commission, passed in Case No.73/2024 has since been paid. So far as the order pertaining to the refund of the check meter cost through adjustment in the energy bill, as directed by the Learned GRF

and finally confirmed by the Hon'ble High Court in the above Writ Petition, it is submitted that a new cubical metering unit was installed on 10.07.2023 free of cost as the Petitioner had deposited the cost of check-meter at the time of initial power supply. It is submitted by the Respondent that there has been due compliance of the order and there is nothing more available for compliance.

4. The Petitioner while strongly asserting that the confirmed order of the Learned GRF has not been fully carried out prays for remand of the matter to the Learned GRF, Balasore for examination as to whether its order has been duly implemented by the Respondent-TPNODL. The representative of the Respondent raises no objection over this part of the request of the Petitioner.
5. In view of the above, we remand the matter to the Learned GRF, Balasore with a direction to submit a report within a month as regards due compliance of the order dated 06.06.2018 of the learned GRF, Balasore passed in C.C.No.117 of 2018 that was duly confirmed in order dated 30.10.2018 of the Learned Ombudsman-II passed in C.R. Case No.19 of 2018 and order dated 11.04.2023 of the Hon'ble High Court, passed in W.P.(C) No.15232 of 2018, by the Respondent-Licensee.
6. The parties are directed to appear before the Learned GRF, Balasore on 10.07.2025 for next course of action in this matter. The office is directed to forward this order along with the Affidavit dated 25.06.2025 of the Executive Engineer, TPNODL, Balasore and all the relevant documents to the Learned GRF, Balasore.
7. With the above observations and directions, the case is disposed of.
